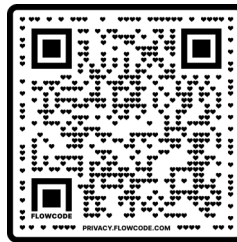
Lois went home to the Lord on Monday, July 18, 2022.
