### EMILIE THRIFT STORE UPDATE





Thank you for your faithful giving. Your confidential individual giving statement for 2023 (Jan-Dec) accompanies this report; thank you to the dedicated volunteers on the counting team and stewardship committee for your hard work recording giving.

We entered 2023 with a balanced budget and received several generous donations from unexpected places throughout the year. We ended the year with a surplus of \$61,199.04, due in part to the generous donations mentioned above and because we have not hired new staff to replace outgoing staff. While we had big increases in Maintenance and Other Expenses (a), and small increases in Insurance and Connectional Ministries (b) these were offset by the reduction in Salaries (c). We are grateful for the surplus, because we have large expenditures expected for the boiler, parsonage, and broker fee for the post office parking lot renewal. We do expect to provide an additional payment to the conference as we have not been funding the full amount they have requested for missions. Additionally, we do expect to hire a new staff member in 2024 to help manage our building. For 2024 we have assumed a modest increase in giving and increases in expenses proportionate with the current market. You may recall that revenue decreased in the last quarter of 2023 due to the departure of Bucks County IU who rented our space for many years. This is enabling the Day School to expand and thus some of this revenue has been replaced. We are grateful for all their hard work with this very important mission of the church. Church leadership will continue to work to ensure our space is utilized in the best manner.

We would like to thank you for your continued support of the Benevolent Funds (Conference Special Giving Sunday's & Missions), as well as the Earmarked Funds (Pastor's Discretionary Fund, I Love My Church, Share-a-Meal, Memorial Fund). The total donated to these funds in 2023 was \$9,152 and is in addition to the amounts shown in the table above. All income is paid out to their respective funds, on a quarterly basis.

Your Finance & Stewardship Committee encourages you to look at electronic giving through "Vanco" as a convenient alternative to traditional giving via envelopes; you can sign-up on the church website using the link under GIVE. Please also consider including your church in your will as your way to deliver a final gift; you can indicate how you would like your gift to be used or have it used for the general good of your church.
