DISCIPLE

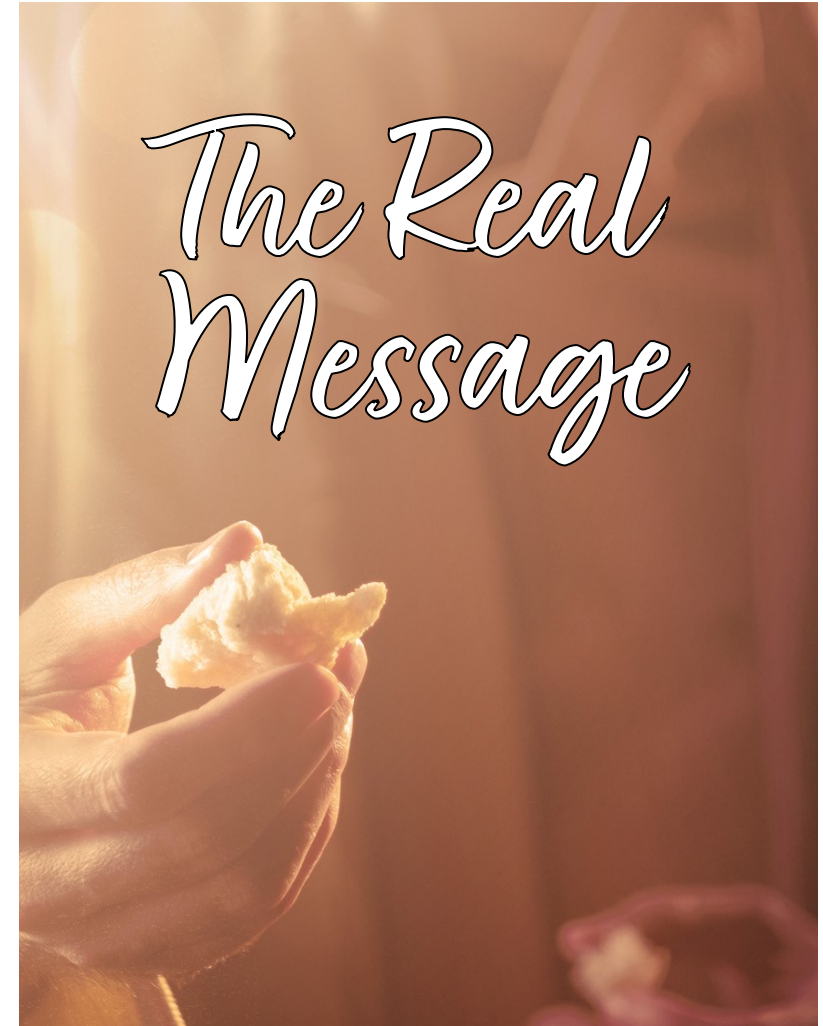
