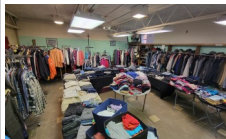

The Social Creed

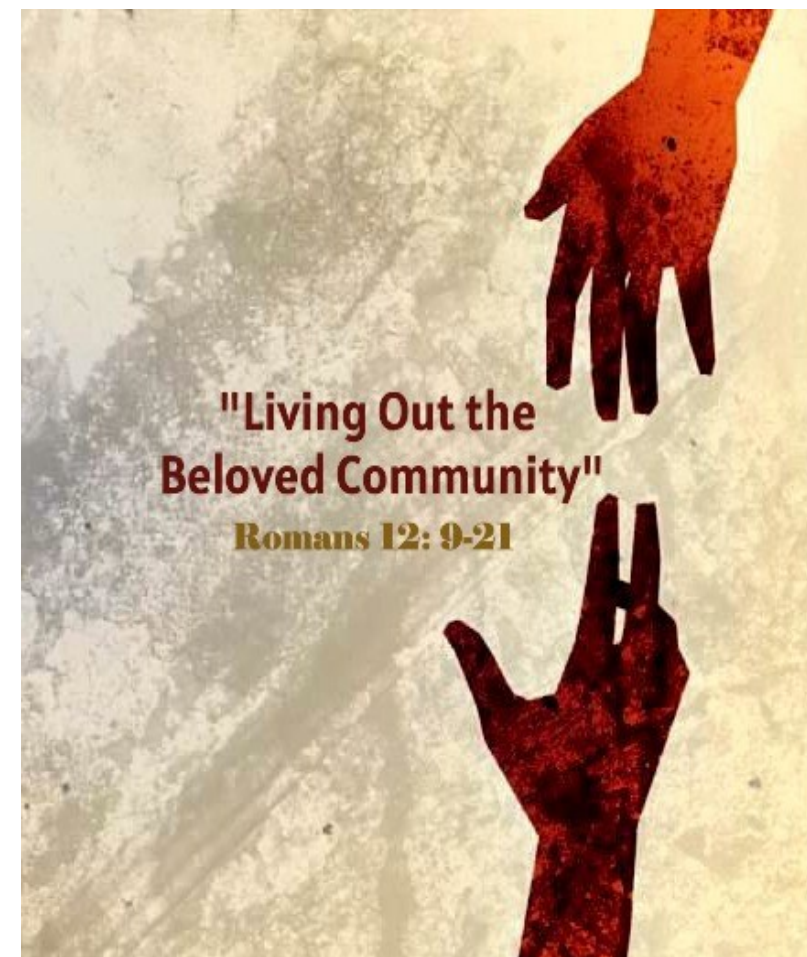
